
FEATURED ARTIST THIS MONTH IS *<u>MINDY AUSTIN</u>*

Add the Aggieland Art Trail app to your phone

- 1. Go to aggielandarttrail.app
- 2. Sign Up (it's free)
- 3. Checkout, add your info and complete the order

4. You will receive the link to your mobile pass in the email.

5. Once you are logged into your pass in Chrome on your Android phone and you want to make it an app on your phone, you must be in Chrome browser. You can follow the directions given in FAQs in the top banner.

• If you see the 3 dots on the top right side of your screen, proceed directly to Step 8.

6. Hold your finger on the 3 horizontal bars at the bottom right on your screen (don't click, hold). Up pops the Chrome info.

7. Pick Open in Chrome Browser

8. tap the 3 dots in the top right corner and look for "Add to Home screen"

9. The app will be installed.
